We will trace St Paul's footsteps in ancient Corinth, Isthmia and Kenchreai, Corinth's eastern harbour where Phoebe the deacon appears to have presided over a house church. Explore the ruins of ancient Kenchreai.

- Explore ruins of Isthmia where St Paul worked
- Visit ruins of Kenchreai early church where Phoebe lived and where St Paul sailed from
- Discover early Christian remains in ancient Corinth
- Visit Epidavros, healing centre of the ancient world and its early Christian basilica
- Visit peaceful 11th Century convent near Epidavros with welcoming nuns
- Visit Nemea, home to an early Christian farming community and ruined temple of Zeus
- Free day with possible trip to Agamemnon's palace in Mycenae
- Free half day in Athens
